## **PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

You must complete:

- 14 units for GDipEcon Core Courses
- 2 units for GDipEcon Program Elective Courses

If Exemptions apply for Core courses, students are to undertake replacement Elective courses. With Head of School approval, a student may include 2 units for a level 7 course as an Elective.

The following is a suggested study plan only. There may be other ways to plan your progression through this program.

The study plan ensures pre-requisite courses are completed first. Students should not attempt courses where they have not completed the UQ pre-requisite(s) or an alternative comparable course completed at undergraduate or postgraduate level.

Not all courses are offered every semester and/or every year. Check courses offerings prior to enrolling.
